

25% Tuition Assistance for Chevron Employees at USC

Academically qualified Chevron employees may earn 25% tuition assistance at USC when pursuing one of the following programs: MS in Petroleum Engineering, MS or Graduate Certificate in Petroleum Engineering (Smart Oilfield Technologies), MS in Petroleum Engineering (Geoscience Technologies), or a Graduate Certificate in Petroleum Engineering (Unconventional Resources). *25% of tuition only (does not cover books).

If awarded, 25% of the tuition will be covered by the USC Viterbi Petroleum Engineering Department and 75% covered by Chevron.

Eligibility:

- US Citizen or Perm. Resident only
- Fully admitted student (Limited Students are not eligible)
- Must maintain a B or better in graduate courses
- Must have authorization from employee's Chevron supervisor
- Upon admission to USC, the applicant needs to discuss his/her program plan with the Director of Petroleum Engineering to obtain approval
