

Tuition & Fees for 28-Unit Master's of Science Programs

This information is for engineering/computer science Master of Science programs offered by the USC Viterbi School of Engineering requiring the successful completion of a minimum of 28 units of graduate engineering coursework.

Tuition and fees for the academic year 2020-2021 are as follows:

Mandatory Fees (approximate)*	\$420

* These fees are: student health service, programming, and Topping Student Aid Fund. There is also a one-time new student fee charged in the student's first semester.
